



HONC 36: 5th September 2021: Adventure through the Cotswolds

The original & classic British Off-Road Endurance Cycling Event, now in its 36th year. (Promoted and organised by Winchcombe Cycling Club* and Cheltenham & County Cycling Club)

Hell of the North Cotswolds (HONC) originally run on the same day as the famous Paris Roubaix event. This year a staggered start from 07.30 until 09.30am from our new venue Sudeley Castle. Winchcombe.

HONC is a Non-Competitive On & Off Road Challenge run under British Cycling Rules & Guidelines, aimed at experienced riders & run over challenging routes across the hills and valleys of the beautiful Cotswolds, using a combination of roads, tracks and bridleways, with significant off-road sections.

Choose on the day between a **100km route** for experienced and fit riders and a **50km route** for those who know just how tough the off-road Cotswold Hills can be. You can also ride a **75km route** by following the 100km route to the Food Stop & then following the 50km to the finish.

Printed route maps will be available at registration. GPX routes will be made available to all registered riders in the week before the event. Routes will be marked by distinctive black & yellow HONC arrows

Food & drink will be available at the start from 07.00am and there will also be a Food Stop at around the half-way point of the 100km & 50km routes where food, water & toilets will be available.

Car Parking, Toilets, & a bike wash will be available at the start at Sudley Castle and Gardens & a cycle recovery service will operate.

Mechanical Support will kindly be providing a mobile repair van at the start & the food stop.
